

Tour four wine regions along the Colorado Front Range

Escape to Colorado wine country, right here on the Front Range! Experience free tasting and touring from our wonderfully diverse selection of Front Range wineries. Front Range vintners are known for producing a wide variety of premium wines, from rich Chardonnays, robust Merlots and crisp Rieslings to wines made from Colorado cherries, peaches, plums and honey. Use this guide to customize your own tour and sample some of the award-winning wines that have earned Colorado top honors in National and International wine competitions.

If your travels include Rocky Mountain National Park or the Estes Park area, be sure to visit the Northern winery region. Trail Ridge Winery in Loveland, a country farm winery, offers 11 vintages to choose from. Settle in on the porch for a chance to linger over a glass of wine. Enjoy The Ciatano Winery just outside of Lyons with Italian-style wine available in a beautiful setting at the Rock 'n River Inn. Continuing up the canyon, visit Snowy Peaks Winery and Valley of the Wind Winery, located in the heart of Estes Park. Sample a wide variety of vintages while soaking up the local flavor and small mountain town hospitality of the Northern winery region.

Staying closer to Denver? Pop over to the Boulder winery region, just half an hour from downtown Denver. Discover the eclectic and intriguing town of Boulder while making the rounds to 5 distinct wineries. Turquoise Mesa, located in Broomfield near Flat Iron Crossing, serves Shiraz, Chardonnay.



Augustina's one-woman winery offers everything from Chardonnay to Shiraz. Bookcliff Vineyards' tasting room is within the Belvedere Belgian Chocolate shop, so in addition to tasting world-class wine, dip into some world-class chocolate! For the unique taste of "honey wine" or mead, head over to the Redstone Meadery. Cap off your day at the Boulder Creek Winery to sample their classic-styled wines, located one mile from Celestial Seasonings Tea Factory and Leanin' Tree Museum of Western Art.

The Denver winery region is comprised of 6 wineries or tasting rooms. Balistreri Vineyards, located in North Denver offers a broad spectrum of varietals from Merlots and Sangiovese to Muscat and Port. For a taste of wine made in the "old-world" traditions brought over from Italy,

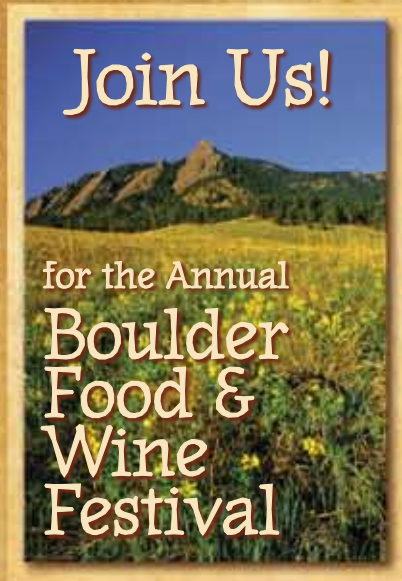
cruise over to Spero Winery. Try a specialty blend at Bonacquisti Wine Company, located in a funky urban setting, only minutes from downtown. Making your way through Downtown, stop in at Tewksbury & Co. tasting room for a sampling of wines from Plum Creek Winery and fine cigars. Head west toward the foothills, to the Avanti Winery in Littleton where you can sample many Colorado premium wines and cigars.

Continue up the hill to the beautiful mountain town of Evergreen to check out Creekside Cellars. Relax on the deck with fine wine and delicious food from their Italian deli while enjoying the rippling waters of Bear Creek.

If the Colorado Springs area attractions are on your list, then check out the Southern winery region. Concetta Cellars at Stoa, located in Castle Rock serves up traditionally crafted wines. And, they are only 2 miles from the

Factory Outlets shopping area. Heading down to Colorado Springs, visit Wines of Colorado, at the base of Pikes Peak. They have the state's largest selection of Colorado wines for sampling and offer casual mountainside dining. Traveling further South, a "must-see" is the Winery

at Holy Cross Abbey. Truly a unique setting on the pastoral grounds of a Monastery and just 12 miles to the Royal Gorge, the Winery at Holy Cross Abbey offers a wide variety of award-winning wines and an incredibly well-stocked gift shop with something for everybody.



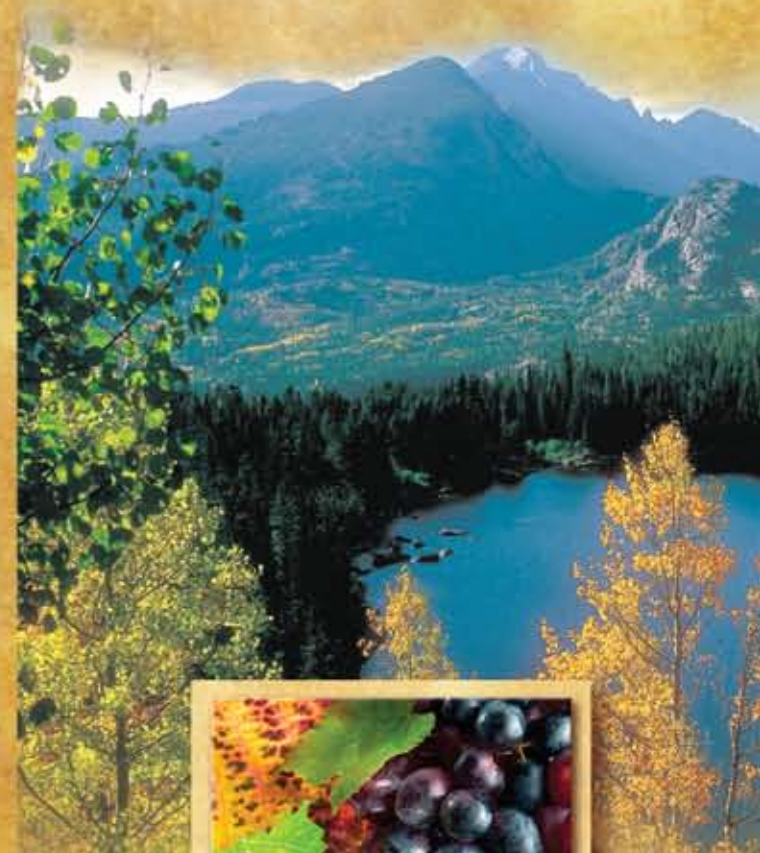
